



**Cleaning and Disinfection Protocol Chart for Cruise Industry

Area Cleaned	Required Supplies	Directions
<i>Toilet Bowls</i>	Brush	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Clean exterior and rim of toilet with Cruise Control. 2. Allow to stand on toilet surfaces for 5-minutes. 3. Clean the rest of the cabin while waiting. 4. Scrub with brush 5. Flush toilet.
<i>Bath/Showers</i>	Spray bottle, brush	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray surfaces of shower stall with solution 2. Use brush to scrub surfaces 3. Spray shower curtain making sure to cover the seams 4. Completely rinse surfaces and allow to air dry. 5. Spray Cruise Control on surfaces and allow to air dry.
<i>Hand Washing Sinks</i>	Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray the surface of the sink and adjacent counter. 2. Use clean micro fiber cloth to wipe surface clean. 3. Allow to air dry.
Bathrooms – Daily Cleaning		
<i>Floors</i>	Mop and bucket, spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fill bucket with RTU solution of Cruise Control. 2. Use clean mop to wipe floors clean. 3. Change the solution when dirty. 4. Allow to air dry.
<i>Bathroom Fixtures & Surfaces</i>	Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray around the base of the toilet bowl. Wipe soil from surfaces and rinse. 2. Spray surfaces again and allow to air dry. 3. Spray Cruise Control RTU solution on walls of bathroom including doors and door handles. 4. Use clean micro-fiber cloth to wipe walls, doors, and door handles clean. Rinse, 5. Spray surfaces with Cruise Control and allow to air dry.

<p><i>Bathrooms - Sick Guests</i></p>	<p>Mop and bucket, spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.</p> <p>This will go into another section.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray around the base of the toilet bowl using Cruise Control RTU solution 2. Spray around the toilet bowl and around the rim. Allow to stand 5-minutes. 3. Spray solution on walls of bathroom including doors and door handles. 4. Use clean micro fiber cloth to wipe the walls and doors clean. 5. Make sure to wipe the entrance door handles to clean and disinfect. 6. Mop floor with solution and keep wet for 5-minutes. Change bucket solution and fresh water mop to remove excess solution. 7. Air dry - Do not rinse.
<p><i>Bedrooms – Daily Cleaning</i></p>	<p>Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloth</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution onto micro fiber cloth until it is wet. 2. Wipe wall surfaces. 3. Wipe telephone hand set and TV remote. 4. Wipe furniture surfaces. 5. Wipe arms and backs of chairs. 6. Wipe Life Jackets. 7. Allow to air dry.
<p><i>Bedrooms – Sick Guests</i></p>	<p>Directional Fogger (Tri-Jet or similar), spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.</p> <p>This will go into another section.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution onto clean micro-fiber cloth until it is wet. 2. Wipe wall surfaces including doors and door handles. 3. Wipe telephone hand set and TV remote. 4. Wipe all furniture surfaces. 5. Wipe arms and backs of chairs. 6. Fog Room with Tri-Jet fogger (Refer to fogging instructions). 7. Allow to air dry.
<p><i>Hand Railings</i></p>	<p>Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution on clean micro-fiber cloth until wet. 2. Thoroughly wipe hand railings to clean. 3. Allow to air dry.

<i>Door Handles</i>	Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution on clean micro-fiber cloth until it is wet. 2. Thoroughly wipe door handles to clean. 3. Allow to air dry.
<i>Fitness Center</i>	<p>Spray bottle, clean towel or sponge</p> <p>This will go into another section</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution on all exercise equipment (including Stationary Bikes, Elliptical Cross Trainers, Stair Climbers, Tread Mills, Nautilus Machines, Medicine Balls, etc.) 2. Wipe with clean towel or sponge. 3. Spray solution on towel until wet. 4. Wipe all surfaces of free weights. 5. Spray solution on exercise mats. 6. Wipe with clean towel or sponge to clean. 7. Allow to air dry.
<i>Furniture</i>	Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution on clean micro-fiber cloth until wet. 2. Wipe furniture surfaces 3. Allow to air dry.
<i>Chairs/Upholstery/Fabric</i>	Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloth.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray solution on clean micro-fiber cloth.. 2. Wipe chairs' armrest, seats and backs and other hard surfaces. 3. Spray fine mist on armrest, seat and backs and wipe with Clean micro-fiber cloth. 4. Allow to air dry.
<i>Carpets</i>	Pressure sprayer, spray bottle, rake - for large areas, brush-for small areas	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray carpet with solution and allow to soak.
<i>Wet Carpet Cleaning Machine – with wand. Large Areas</i>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray carpet with solution with pressure sprayer. 2. Rake surface of carpet to spread evenly. 3. Allow 5-minute of contact time. 4. Rinse with clean water in carpet extractor cleaning machine.
<i>Wet Carpet Cleaning Machine – with wand.</i>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray area of carpet with fine mist of product using spray bottle.

Small Areas		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Rake surface of carpet area. 3. Allow to air dry.
Curtains	Spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloth.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray fine mist of solution on curtains. 2. Allow to air dry.
Hard Floors	Mop and bucket,	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fill bucket with RTU solution of Cruise Control. 2. Use clean mop to wipe floors clean. 3. Change the solution when dirty. 4. Allow to air dry.
Tables	Spray bottle, clean towel or sponge	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray fine mist of solution on table surfaces. 2. Wipe with clean micro-fiber cloth to clean surfaces. 3. Allow to air dry.
Counters	Spray bottle, clean towel or sponge	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spray counter with fine mist of solution. 2. Wipe with clean micro-fiber cloth to clean surfaces. 3. Allow to air dry.
Vomit Hard Surface	<p>Brush, scupper, spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloth.</p> <p>Will move to another section</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The spill area must be cleaned of noticeable organic material before the disinfecting step. 2. Apply solution to spill and allow 5 min. of contact time. 3. After 5 minutes remove fluid capable of transmitting infection with disposable towels. Discard the micro-fiber cloth in a plastic-lined waste receptacle. 4. After cleaning, reapply solution to spill areas and allow wet contact for at least 5 minutes. 5. Reapply solution to ensure a complete wet contact. Wipe dry and discard the cloth in a plastic-lined waste receptacle.
Vomit Carpeted Areas	<p>Brush, scupper, spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths.</p> <p>Will move to another section.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The spill area must be cleaned of noticeable organic material before the disinfecting step. Apply solution to spill and allow to dwell for 5 minutes. 2. After 5 minutes remove fluid capable of transmitting infection with disposable micro-fiber cloths. Discard the cloths in a plastic-lined waste receptacle. 3. After cleaning, reapply solution to spill areas and allow

		<p>wet contact for at least 5 minutes. Ensure deep saturation of solution into carpet.</p> <p>4. Rinse carpet using clean water:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Pour water on carpet. Blot area with clean rag. Repeat twice.
<p>Body fluids Hard Surface</p>	<p>Brush, scupper, spray bottle, clean micro-fiber cloths</p> <p>Will move to another section.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The spill area must be cleaned of noticeable organic material before the disinfecting step. Apply solution to spill and allow 5 minutes of dwell time. After 5 minutes remove fluid capable of transmitting infection with disposable towels. Discard the cloth in a plastic-lined waste receptacle. After cleaning, reapply solution to spill areas and allow wet contact for at least 5 minutes. Reapply solution to guarantee a wet contact. Wipe dry and discard the cloth in a plastic-lined waste receptacle.
<p>Body fluids Carpeted Areas</p>	<p>Move to another section</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The spill area must be cleaned of noticeable organic material before the disinfecting step. Apply solution to spill and allow 5 minutes of dwell time. After 5 minutes - remove fluid capable of transmitting infection with disposable towels. Discard the towels in a plastic-lined waste receptacle After cleaning, reapply solution to spill areas and allow wet contact for at least 5 minutes to guarantee deep saturation of solution into carpet. Rinse carpet using clean water: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Pour water on carpet. Blot area with clean rag.
